## **GUELPH PC'S KICK-START THE RACE TO BE THEIR MPP CANDIDATE IN STYLE!**

Guelph – June 10, 2011 - The race to be Guelph's PC candidate for the October 6<sup>th</sup> provincial election got off to a great start this morning with a well-attended breakfast fundraiser at the Symposium Café. The three PC nominees – Bob Senechal, Greg Schirk, and Rob Demille – introduced themselves to the 40+ attendees, among whom were Ted Chudleigh (MPP – Halton), Ted Arnott (MPP – Wellington-Halton Hills) , and Brent Barr (former Guelph Federal Conservative Party candidate).

The guest speaker for this event was Frank Klees (MPP – Newmarket-Aurora). Mr. Klees started by noting that he is getting “strong signals from Ontarians that they are ready for a change... (given) what has happened to the province under Dalton McGuinty”. He strongly endorsed Tim Hudak's “*changebook*” policy document because it is “crisp and clean” and was developed based on consulting with groups of citizens and understanding their needs. He felt that “*changebook*” should appeal to everyone in Guelph because, like all other Ontarians, “people in Guelph are, at their core, small-c conservatives who want good stewardship from their government. “ He also encouraged everyone in Guelph to get involved in the upcoming provincial election and pointed out that “if you don't get involved in the political process, you are destined to be governed by those who do!”

This event was hosted by the Guelph Provincial Progressive Conservative Association. In addition to a financial donation, attendees were asked to bring food for the Guelph Food Bank. As a thank-you gift to the guest speaker, the food that was brought in was donated to the Food Bank in Mr. Klees' name.
